FRAUD & SCAM ALERT TARGETING SENIORS - BE ALERT AND STAY SAFE

On the rise are fraudsters phoning unsuspecting people, especially seniors, claiming they are calling from "your bank's fraud department". Here's how the scam works:



- You'll receive a phone call from your bank from someone in the Fraud Department.
- The scammer explains that your card has been flagged for suspicious activity, and you need to prove that you have your card.
- They will then ask questions asking for your details including card number and 3-digit code.

Police say, "hang up straight away and call your bank if you think there is an issue".
